TRANSPORT ON ARRIVAL

HOW TO GET FROM LJUBLJANA AIRPORT TO THE CITY CENTRE

The distance from Ljubljana International Airport to the city is 30 kilometres and it will take 30 minutes driving by taxi and it will cost around 30-35€. The best option might be to book a transfer via [GoOpti](#). The shared transfer will cost between 12€ to 35€.

There are public bus operators that can take you from Ljubljana to the airport or vice versa. The journey takes 45 minutes, the cost is around 4 euros and you buy your tickets directly from the driver. Public bus 28 route operates between Ljubljana bus station and Ljubljana airport.

MOVING AROUND IN THE CITY

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

It is very easy to get around in Ljubljana. As the city center is relatively small, you can simply walk it or rent a bike. Don't search for the subway, because of its size Ljubljana has never had it. To get to other parts of Ljubljana you should use public transport like the city bus system or a taxi.

BUS

To travel with Ljubljana city buses you will need an Urbana Card (find information about Urbana Card usage on this site below). One journey costs 1.30 € and allows you to change as many buses as you need in a time of 90 minutes without additional charge. When you enter a bus, make sure you approach your Urbana Card to the scanner (there are two on each bus, usually at the front door). When you hear a beep sound, a transaction is done.

You can get Urbana Card for a one-time fee of 2€ on so-called *Urbanomats* and also at:

- news-stands
- tobacco shops
- petrol stations
- tourist offices
- post offices.

BICYCLE

From May 2011, Ljubljana residents and visitors to the capital city can ride city bikes in the self-service Bicikelj rental system, which complements other forms of public transport in the city. It is easy to become a user. All you need is an e-mail address and a PIN code. If you stay in Ljubljana for a couple of months or longer, get yourself a yearly subscription, which is almost free of charge: 3 €. If just for a couple of days or a week, weekly subscription will suffice. The cost of registration is one Euro. There is a bike station in front of both tennis venues, Tivoli & Svoboda. More info:

Practice Courts: Thursday, 26 May from 15h-18h

Stringing Service

There is no stringing service directly at either of the venues, however, we have a professional stringer who will be on call and come to collect your tennis racket(s) and bring them back ASAP. You will be able to leave it at the tournament desk and we will liaise with him. Prices: approx. 10 EUR if you have your own strings and approx. 20 EUR if you don't.

WEATHER

June is a wonderful time to visit Slovenia. Sitting in the shoulder season, the month of May sees fewer tourists than the summer high season of June to August. The average minimum temperature (usually the minimum temperature is noted during the night) in Ljubljana in May is 10.0°C (50°F). The amount of rain in May is high with an average of 109mm (4.3in). It rains on average a total of 14 days. The average maximum daytime temperature lies around 21.5°C (70.7°F). If you enjoy looking at a blue sky and love the sun then this is a great time to go to Ljubljana with 234 hours of sun.

Current weather forecast is some rain showers during the week but hopefully no mayor setbacks for us during the tournament itself. We do have a plan B for the player's dinner and party just in case!
